Description

This function displays a picture of a cat and plays a short sound clip containing cat meow. It is possible that once in a while you might get a picture that is in no way feline related. In such cases, just try again.

Usage

```
kittyR(url = NULL, meow = TRUE, sound = 3, only_kitten = FALSE, ...)
```

Arguments

<code>url</code>	URL for the source from which individual image URLs are to be extracted. Default is NULL. If NULL, a randomly drawn image from the default collection will be shown.
<code>meow</code>	Logical that decides whether to play a meow sound along with the picture of a cat.
<code>sound</code>	A character string or a number specifying what sound to be played by either specifying one of the built in sounds, specifying the path to a .wav file or specifying an URL. There are currently 6 meows included. The default is 3.
<code>only_kitten</code>	Logical that decides whether only kitten pics should be selected (default: FALSE).
<code>...</code>	Additional arguments (currently ignored).

Value

A photo of a cat is downloaded and displayed in the plot window.

Examples

```
library(kittyR)

# relying on default collection
set.seed(122)
kittyR(meow = FALSE)
```

```
# in case you want only pics of kittens
set.seed(111)
kittyR(meow = FALSE, only_kitten = TRUE)

# provide a custom URL
set.seed(300)
kittyR(
  url = "https://unsplash.com/s/photos/cat/",
  meow = FALSE
)
```

Description

Mostly useful for internal workings of this package, this function extracts images at given URL and returns it in a dataframe.

Usage

```
kitty_pics_df(url, ...)
```

Arguments

url	URL for the source from which individual image URLs are to be extracted.
...	Currently ignored.

Value

A tibble containing extracted details from the provided URL.

Examples

```
set.seed(123)
kittyR::kitty_pics_df("https://unsplash.com/s/photos/kitten/")
```

meowR

Play a short kitty meow sound

Description

meowR is inspired by beepR::beep, which plays a short sound to notify you, for example, when a script has finished. Instead of a beep, this function produced a meow.

Usage

```
meowR(sound = 3)
```

Arguments

sound	A character string or a number specifying what sound to be played by either specifying one of the built in sounds, specifying the path to a .wav file or specifying an URL. There are currently 6 meows included. The default is 3.
